Dear Hoboken Charter Community,

The Hoboken Charter School Board of Trustees' Facilities Committee has been working in close conjunction with parent volunteers and the committees of the Parents' Association to finalize facilities plans for the school year beginning September 2010.

At our forum held December 2, 2009, a variety of potential sites for the relocation of our K-8 school was presented. Since that time, the most viable options were further investigated and additional properties assessed. The school is now in negotiation for two properties, one of which has been reviewed and received necessary approval by the Hudson County Superintendent of Schools. Additionally, the Funding Committee has received positive responses from lenders for loan applications to assist in improving the facilities.

It was the hope and sincere intention of the Board of Trustees that a location could be determined in January of this year; however, complexity of relocating our school in the Hoboken real estate environment has required more time than previously anticipated. The Facilities Committee is intimately aware of the interests of parents and all members of our community to provide a confirmed location for our school. The majority of Facilities Committee members are professional volunteers from the parent base who share that priority.

At the earliest possible opportunity, an announcement of a confirmed decision will be provided and we are confident that will happen soon.
